## Old Business:

## **New Business:**

NEMCOG grant assistance – Phil Czech stated from zoom meeting not a factor at this point.

Vacant Lot assessments – Jim Barnwell talked of vacant and vacant buildable lots. Like to use Parcel, 1 parcel could equal 3 lots as an example. He believes buildable lots should be assessed for some costs such as mains and the WWTP, not for individual runs. Phil Czech said he believed it should be up to the property owner, with a deadline for that choice.

- Equal costs vs equal benefits. People who don't have room for a new septic would benefit more from a sewer.
