PUBLIC PARTICIPATION RULES

Persons wishing to address the Board at the appropriate place in the meeting agenda shall be subject to the following:

1. Each person shall be allowed to speak on an agenda item one (1) time when the issue is taken up by the Board, and one (1) time on non-agenda issues during Public Comments, for up to three minutes. An extension of time may be granted by the chairman if the extension will not interfere with conduct of board business or with other persons who also wish to address the board.
2. Each person wishing to address the Board shall be acknowledged by the Chairman and may remain by their seat or may sit/stand at the designated table and shall identify themselves by name and address.
3. A delegation representing an organization may request in advance or during Public Comment to address the Board. The delegation may select up to five representatives to speak on its behalf, for a total time as determined by the Chairman.
4. The Board shall be provided by the speaker with copies of all written comments submitted.
5. Persons addressing the Board shall observe the rules of common courtesy. Complaints should first be considered through proper channels before being considered by the Board. Personal attacks against a Board member or township employee unrelated to the Board member's or employee's performance of duties shall not be permitted. Board members or employees may request a closed hearing to hear complaints related to the performance of their official duties.
6. Board members may question speakers but are not obligated to answer questions or make statements or commitment in response to issues raised by the public. In general, such issues will be referred to the Chairman for investigation, study, and recommendation or designated as a future agenda item.
7. Disorderly Conduct. The Chairperson shall call to order any person who is being disorderly by speaking or otherwise disrupting the proceedings, by failing to be germane, by speaking longer than the allotted time, or by speaking vulgarities. Such person shall thereupon be seated until the Chairperson shall have determined whether the person is in order. If a person so engaged in presentation shall be ruled out of order, he or she shall not be permitted to speak further at the same meeting except upon special leave by the Board. If the person shall continue to be disorderly and to disrupt the meeting, the chairperson may order the Sergeant at Arms to remove the person from the meeting. No person shall be removed from a public meeting except for an actual breach of the peace committed at the meeting.

These rules, having been adopted by the Gerrish Lyon Utility Authority at a meeting held on 5/13/2024, may be amended or rescinded by a majority vote of the Board elected and serving. They shall remain in effect until amended or rescinded. Any proposed amendment to these rules, properly presented to the Gerrish Lyon Utility Authority shall take immediate effect when adopted, unless the board, at the time of adoption, stipulates otherwise. These rules also may be reviewed at the beginning of each calendar year.
