\* \$100,000 Michigan Department of Agriculture Rural Development Grant (MDARD) . Grant Agreement in place with funds designated to pursue the final Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes and Energy (EGLE) discharge permit for the Wastewater Treatment Plant.

\* \$40,000 Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes and Energy (EGLE) Water Resource Division Non Point Source Grant. Primary purposes are administrative to include the retaining of Engineering services to assist with the next steps required in process. Work with municipal advisors to further develop assessing process and funding. Work required of a grant consultant to assist in grant applications. This grant is anticipated to be in place by mid September.

\* \$1,000,000 Federal United States Environmental Protection Agency Community Grant. These monies are intended for Project Development, Community Outreach, Assisting in background information for assessment roll, grant administration. Mapping to consist of base mapping of parcels, right-of-ways, topography and existing utilities. Design Development of the Wastewater Treatment and Collection System. This grant is anticipated to be in place by end of September, early October.
